Mae nifer o gartis a siopau te rhagorol yng nghanol Llandrillo yn Rhos, ac fe aiff â'r dath â chi hebio i dair tataru. lle gallwch archebu bwyd, felly mae digon o gyfle i orffwys a bwyta. Fe ewch chi hebio i nifer o feinciau hefyd fel y gallwch chi fynd wrth eich pwysau a gortffws fel y mynwnch chi a mynhanu'r dath!

Mae lletydd parcio i'w cael ar hyd y rhan fwyaf o'r promenâd. Mae dau faes parcio hefyd (wedi eu marcio â P ar y map). Os byddwch yn defnyddio un o'r rhain dechreuwch y dath wrth y rff agosaf ar y map.

Introduction

This guide aims to take you on a tour of the attractive village of Rhos-on-Sea and introduce you to its surprisingly rich heritage.



Rhos has strong associations with an astonishing variety of historical periods and events starting with Roman times, but also including the time of the Celtic saints, the Middle Ages, and then Elizabethan times

right through to the present day. Use this trail to discover many fascinating buildings and historic sites and learn about the interesting people who are associated with some of them.

The core of the trail is a walk of about an hour centred on the promenade. Three optional extensions have been added for those with more time and energy. The complete trail, including the delightful walk to the Bryn Eurn hill fort, (well worth it for the superb views alone)



would take between 3 and 3 1/2 hours. As the route is circular, it can be joined at any point. *Directions are in blue type* and points of interest are given a

number, so it's easy to follow. There are a number of excellent cafes and teashops in the centre of Rhos, and you will pass three pubs on the walk, all serving food, so rest and refreshment should be readily available. You will also pass a number of benches if you would like some additional pauses so as to take in the pleasant atmosphere!

There is parking along most of the promenade. There are also two car parks (marked P on the map). If you use one of these, simply start the walk at the nearest number shown on the map.

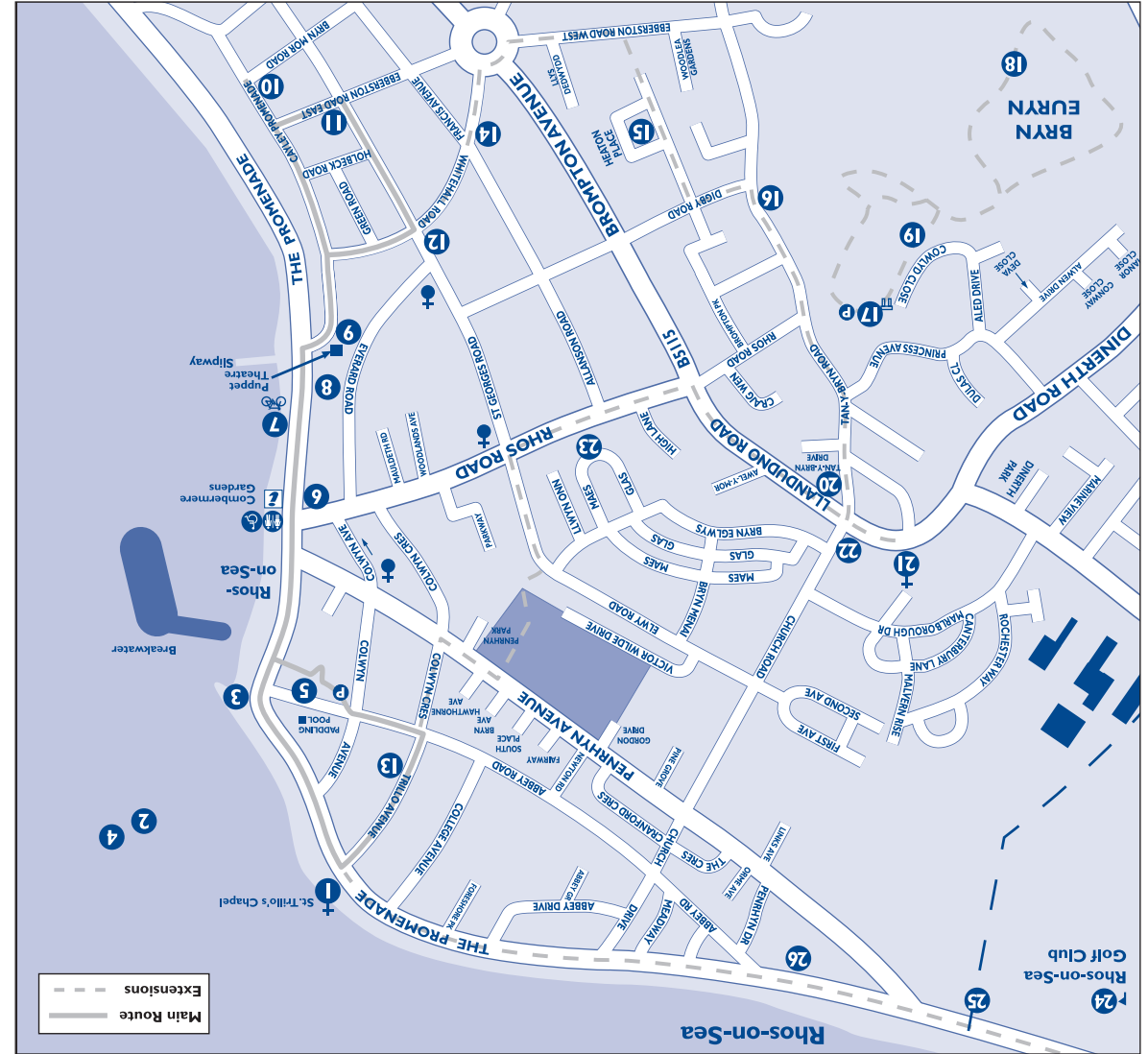
